SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

DEADLINES

All abstract submissions must be made electronically through Collage's online abstract submission system. The site opens on **May 25**, and the abstract submission deadline is **June 26**, 2017, 16:00 (GMT).

A Scientific Committee will score the contributions and the Authors will be notified about the abstract acceptance by **July 14**. The best accepted abstracts will be presented during the oral sessions of the meeting (<u>10 minutes for presentation plus 2 for discussion</u>), while the other accepted contributions will be presented as posters.

Please note: All presenters must register at the time of confirming their acceptance of the contribution and pay the conference registration fee.

FORMAT

Accepted posters will be presented during the days of the Meeting, namely September 28-30, 2017.

A 70 x 100 cm tackboard will be provided for your use.

SUBMITTER and AUTHORS

- Are you an author who will be presenting at the session? (Presenting Author, mark with a flag like this *)
- Are you an author, but will not be presenting at the session? (Author Only)

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

The Abstract word limit is 350 words. The contribution will be submitted in the format reported below and will consist of the following sections:

- Background
- Patients and methods (or materials and methods)
- Results
- Conclusions and perspectives
- Language: Use English only.
- List all Authors in the space provided.
- No more than one table and one figure can be included in the abstract body.

GENERAL SUBMISSION AGREEMENT

By submitting a proposal to present at the International Meeting on Childhood MDS and SAA (EWOG-MDS/SAA)-, you explicitly agree:

- That the presenting author shall register for the Congress
- To present in the time slot and format assigned by the Program Committee.
- If accepted, to adhere to the deadlines as detailed in the acceptance notification regarding additional information, presentation materials, etc.
- To provide appropriate evidence to support any claims related to efficacy, validity, or reliability of approaches to assessment or treatment.
- To complete the required disclosures that identify any financial or nonfinancial relationship that may create a conflict of interest or the appearance of a conflict of interest.
- To update your disclosure information and inform COLLAGE if you develop or acquire a financial or nonfinancial interest related to the content of your presentation at any time before the Meeting.
- To present a slide at the beginning of your oral presentation that discloses the financial and nonfinancial relationships of each author of the session. If your contribution is a poster session, you will post your disclosure information on the poster board.
- That any research in which you participated and may be discussing in this presentation is in compliance with mandated national and institutional policies and procedures pertaining to animal and/or human subjects research.
- To ensure the privacy of patients.
- To obtain written permission from copyright holders for the use of any previously published material in your presentation or handouts.
